# What Do I Wear?

- Shirt
  - A plain white shirt with a collar
  - Any sleeves are okay — short, long, or no sleeves
- Bottoms
  - Choose bottoms that fit the event
  - Choose white jeans for formal events such as the Fair
  - Choose blue jeans for informal events such as parades
- Note: Always follow the 4-H Dress Guidelines



# Tie or Scarf?



- Tie or scarf optional:
  - Wear a 4-H tie OR scarf under your collar
- Pick the option:
  - That feels most comfortable to you
- For casual events:
  - Wear your club or county 4-H shirt
- Remember:
  - No hat needed for casual events!

# The Official 4-H Hat



- Hat
  - Green hat with the 4-H clover and UC ANR logo
  - Only California has an official 4-H hat!
- Pins
  - Many members put their achievement pins on their hats
- Optional
  - The hat is fun to wear — but NOT required



# 4-H Hat: Left Side

## Left Side of the Hat

- Place All-Star, Platinum, Gold, Silver, or Bronze Stars in front. Members may "cascade" the stars.
- Place Junior/Teen Leader emblems behind the stars.
- Medals may be worn on either side of the hat, but the left is recommended. No other pin or ribbon should be worn on the hat other than 4-H related items. Some items that should not be worn on the hat include buttons, fair medals, convention badges, or other regalia.



# 4-H Hat: Right Side



## Right Side of the Hat

- A year completion pin and stripe are earned for each year completed in 4-H.
- If a member earns more years stripes than they can fit on the right side of the hat, they may "wrap around" their stripes and continue onto the left side the hat.
- Align Officer Pins and 100% Attendance pins with the year the pin was earned.
- Fasten year pins *above* the stripe, starting with the primary pins next to the 4-H Clover.
- Fasten 100% Attendance below the stripe of the year that the pin was earned.

11 years old to 13 years old



14 years old to 19 years old

Bronze Star:   
Complete at least  
5 of the 8 PDR  
categories.

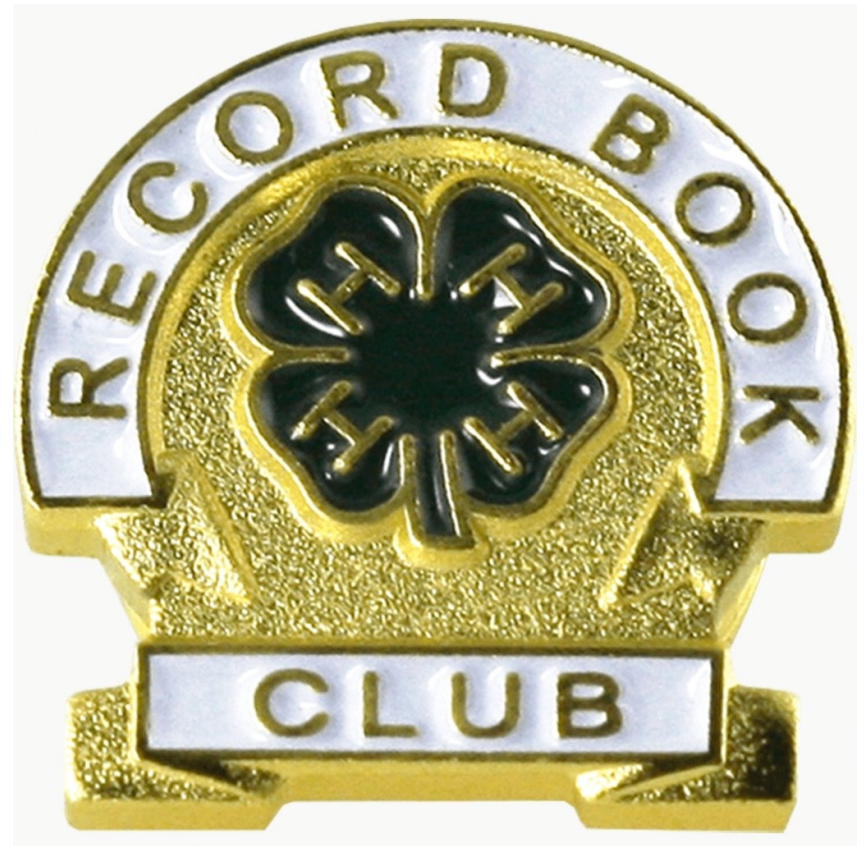
Silver Star:   
Complete at least  
6 of the 8 PDR  
categories.

Gold Star:   
Complete at least  
7 of the 8 PDR  
categories.

Platinum Star:   
Complete all 8  
PDR categories.
